Cybertips of the Week

- 08** Think before you click. **Criminals can use masked links** to hide their true destination and for malicious purposes.
- 09** Be cautious of emails with trending topics. **Cybercriminals take advantage of topical events** to lure you to potentially malicious websites. Always use well-established and reputable sources.
- 10** Manage your email. Spam is a favored method used by cyber criminals to deliver malware. **Be careful where you submit your email address** and unsubscribe to unnecessary sites.
- 11** Enable a device lock. **Use a password or PIN** to secure your device and never leave your laptop, smartphone, or tablet unlocked while you're away.
- 12** Be careful when downloading/installing mobile apps. **Use only the official app stores** and disable the option to install third-party apps.
- 13** Be proactive about security. **Backup your data regularly** and research/use security features which will help protect your data.
