Here are a few tips to help you identify genuine notes.





FEEL



Polymer notes feel

smoother than paper.

Run your fingers over









When you hold the note up to the light you will see:


- A clear window that can be seen from the front and back of the note.
- The number 100 appearing in the blue print.

TILT



As you move the note around you will see:

4 Areas with a shimmering gold ink.





If you look at the note under UV light you will see that some areas of the note glow. This tip is particularly useful for businesses.

WARNING:

Forging, distributing or knowingly being in possession of counterfeit currency notes are serious criminal offences, with penalties ranging from \$100,000 in fines to life imprisonment.
