



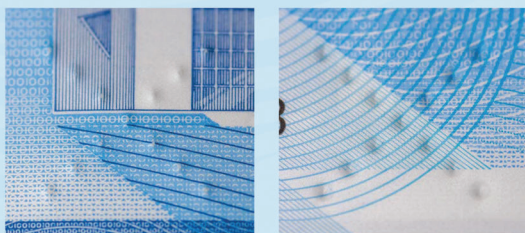

KNOW YOUR MONEY

Here are a few tips to help you identify genuine notes.



FEEL

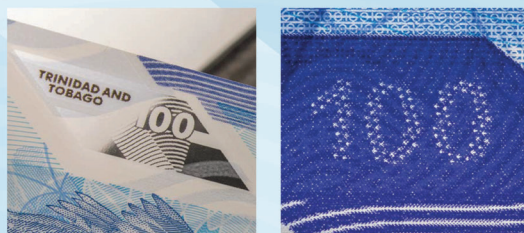


Polymer notes feel smoother than paper.

- 1 Run your fingers over the bottom corner of the note to feel the X.



LOOK



When you hold the note up to the light you will see:

- 2 A clear window that can be seen from the front and back of the note.
- 3 The number 100 appearing in the blue print.

TILT



As you move the note around you will see:

- 4 Areas with a shimmering gold ink.

If you look at the note under UV light you will see that some areas of the note glow. This tip is particularly useful for businesses.

WARNING:

Forging, distributing or knowingly being in possession of counterfeit currency notes are serious criminal offences, with penalties ranging from \$100,000 in fines to life imprisonment.
