2. Programme Designer

You will design and implement a RIM assessment programme to assure compliance with internal and external requirements.

3. Policy Formulator

You will develop Records and Information Management (RIM) policies consistent with the Information Governance framework and associated policies and procedures, and you will be responsible for designing and implementing a system classification scheme and taxonomies.

4. Project Manager

You will be responsible for developing, implementing, administering, managing and maintaining an enterprise content management system with records management capabilities, data governance and data privacy and protection programmes.

5. Collaborator

You will establish objectives and collaborate with the Financial Information Technology Services Department to meet the requirements for managing repositories and other information assets.

You will be responsible for leading a team of qualified professionals.
